Generation Australia has designed the JWD Program for First Nations learners

This program is 100% online part-time from Monday to Friday 9am-3pm (AEST), for 16 weeks. This includes a balance of tech skills and BSMs.

This is for anyone who has a passion/interest for tech, but experience isnt required. This is not for folks who are currently working, studying, in training full time.

This program is 100% free to the learner. If you dont have access to tech/wifi we can certainly help.

COURSE CONTENT

Generation programs are designed to not only build technical skills but prepare you to achieve professional and personal success. In the Generation context, these skills are called 'Behavioural Skills' and 'Mindsets'. We believe the four mindsets taught in our programs will help participants become high performers on the job and achieve success in work and in life.

Our Junior Web Developer program reflects the most valuable skills required to kickstart a new career in the tech industry. The curriculum is equally committed to personal development as it is to technical knowledge and includes holistic support such as mentorship and coaching for every learner.

Full participation from learners is vital as content and instruction is provided during live Zoom sessions.

The 2-week Learner Prep Program is designed to provide selected individuals with additional pre-program support across technical platform set up, behavioural skills and mindsets foundations, wellbeing skills and learning needs identification. These modules aim to help set you up for success in the full program!



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Mentoring Support

ABOUT

Generation Australia aims to support our participants to find meaningful employment. As every participant has diverse backgrounds, challenges and goals, we provide mentoring as a means of supporting each individual student in a way that assists their unique set of circumstances. Mentoring is provided to every participant whilst enrolled in a Generation Program and is a requirement for completing the program.

HOW IT WORKS

As a participant of Generation, you are automatically connected with a First Nations Mentor. Our Mentor team have diverse professional support backgrounds, including psychology, HR, Social Work, Career coaching and holistic services. Your mentor will conduct formal check-ins with you throughout the program, with the option of in-person mentorship and access to learning hub in Adelaide and Sydney.

The Check-Ins cover;

- Relationship Building
- Identifying Goals
- Wellbeing
- Employment Essentials
- Personal Growth
- Planning for the future





Mentors are also available if a mentee needs to be referred to other services or to establish ongoing support after the program. For example, a Mentor may connect a mentee with ongoing psychology appointments or family support services.

Mentors are on call if a participant needs assistance outside of formal check-ins. Contact with your mentor lasts for the entire program and an additional month afterwards, with the aim to have a participant feel confident in their capabilities and strengths to find and keep employment that is satisfying and sustainable.

Making sure you're eligible.

ELIGIBILITY

You can apply for the program if you:

- Live in Adelaide or Sydney*
- Are not currently in full-time employment, education or training
- Have a passion for tech
- Can participate online in all classes 5 days/week, 9am-3pm for 16 weeks
- Identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- Are proficient in English literacy and numeracy

**Locations are based on available support measures for this program. If you live outside these areas, you may still be eligible to enrol. Contact us for more information

Once you register, the application steps are:

1. ONLINE APPLICATION FORM 2. LEARN MORE ABOUT JWD 3. MEET US FOR AN INTERVIEW 4. PREP PROGRAM (ONLINE)

The application process

Once you register, the application steps are:

- 1. **ONLINE APPLICATION FORM** Fill out the application form online.
- 2. **MEET US -** We will check your eligibility for the program and invite you to an online video interview. This interview will be with a member of the Generation team and we will email you the questions we will ask in the interview beforehand.
- 3. **ENROLMENT** Once we have met you and approved the online tasks completed, you will be invited to fill out an online Generation enrolment form to secure your spot on the program.
- 4. **2-WEEK PREP PROGRAM (ONLINE)** During orientation, you will get to meet your trainers, program coordinator, and fellow classmates. You may also be provided with pre-reading material to get you prepared for classes.
